A Spectacular Performance of Song, Music, and Dance, by the China Children's Art Troupe of Friendship

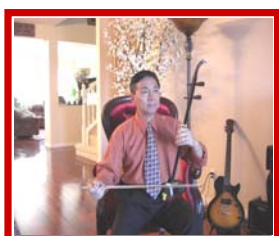

The Spectrum Dance Ensemble, will perform several group and solo numbers, choreographed by Pearl Wardlow and Stacy Ordaz. ▶▶▶



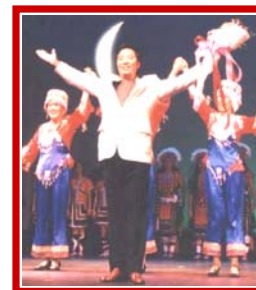
James Lu, performing on the Erhu (Chinese violin).
